

Jumping Jacks

PARKING POLICY

Jumping Jacks actively encourages parents to walk, ride bicycles or utilise public transport where possible in order to get to our site.

In the event whereby parents must use a vehicle to get to us, please bear in mind that Jumping Jacks is situated on a courtyard that is also occupied by two other business. For this reason it is prohibited for staff and parents to use the courtyard for parking at any time. Parents and staff must use the main high street and/or neighbouring roads to park their vehicle when accessing Jumping Jacks.

Please be aware that parking is not permitted outside of the post office/shop located directly opposite the Jumping Jacks premises and is only available for customer parking. We ask all parents and staff to avoid parking on the road outside of the shop during their opening hours.

In line with our travel plan outlined by Surrey County Council, we ask all parents;

- To not park on the courtyard at any time.
- To not turn around in the courtyard at any time.
- To find parking on the high street or neighbouring roads when dropping off and collecting their children.
- To be aware that parking outside of the shop/post office opposite our premises is strictly **prohibited**
- To be cautious that any parking when dropping off or collecting children does not infringe on other road users or our neighbours.
- To utilise the parent WhatsApp group when collecting children so that handovers are as swift as possible.
- To prebook meetings ahead of time with senior staff for discussions regarding your child to avoid congestion and delays at collection times.

Jumping Jacks staff will endeavour to ensure that all children are ready to leave in a timely manner so that busier times during handovers do not cause further congestion on the high street. Staff will of course pass on any urgent messages when needed but will refrain from lengthy discussions at the door.
